General Shortcuts

Windows key	Opens or closes the Start menu.	
Windows key + D	Shows or hides the desktop.	
Windows key + L	Locks the computer.	
Alt + Tab	Switches between open applications.	
Ctrl + Shift + Esc	Opens Task Manager directly.	
Alt + F4	Closes the active window.	

File Explorer Shortcuts

Windows key + E	Opens File Explorer.
Ctrl + N	Opens a new File Explorer window.
Ctrl + Shift + N	Creates a new folder.
Ctrl + W	Closes the active File Explorer window.

Virtual Desktop Shortcuts

Windows key + Ctrl + D	Creates a new virtual desktop.
Windows key + Ctrl +	Switches between virtual desktops.
Left/Right arrow	
Windows key + Ctrl + F4	Closes the current virtual desktop.

Taskbar Shortcuts

Windows key + number (1-9)	Opens the corresponding application on the taskbar.
Windows key + T	Focuses on the taskbar. Use arrow keys to navigate
	and Enter to open.
Shift + click on a taskbar icon	Opens a new instance of the application.



System Shortcuts

Windows key + I	Opens the Settings app.
Windows key + X	Opens the power user menu.
Windows key + Print Screen	Takes a screenshot and saves it to the Screenshots folder.
Windows key + Pause/Break	Opens System Properties.

Text Editing Shortcuts

Ctrl + C	Copies selected text.
Ctrl + X	Cuts selected text.
Ctrl + V	Pastes copied/cut text.
Ctrl + Z	Undoes the last action.
Ctrl + Y	Redoes the last undone action.

Task View Shortcuts

Windows key + Tab	Opens Task View.
Alt + Tab	Switches between open applications
	within Task View.
