What Is It?

[Slash commands](#) are quick actions that you can type directly into the **Search/Command Box** at the top of the Teams interface to navigate, communicate, or perform common tasks.

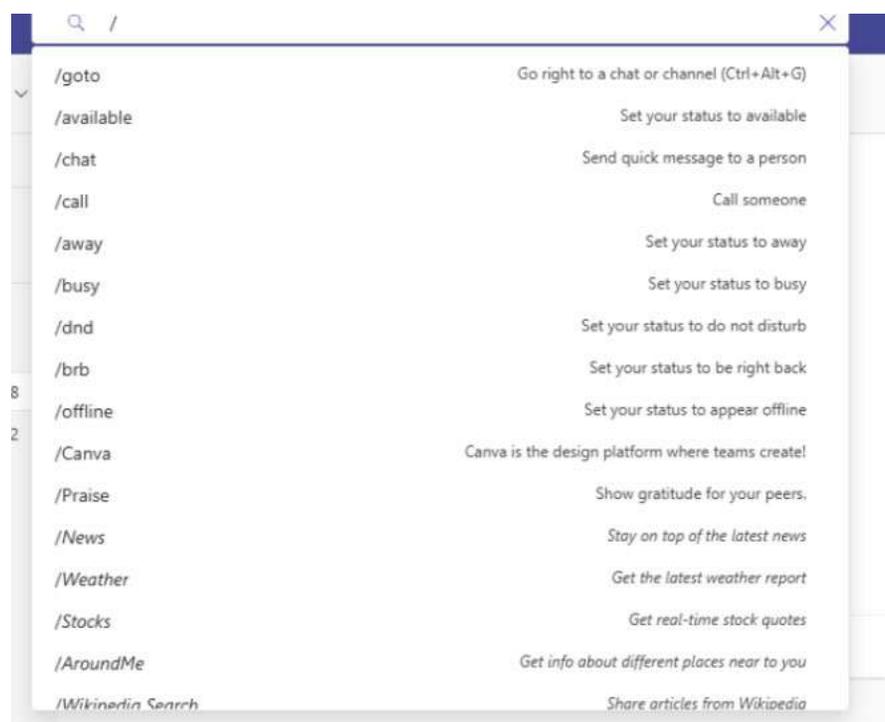
Why Would I Use It?

To work faster without leaving the keyboard. Slash commands eliminate the need to click through multiple menus. You can change your status, jump to recent files, or send a quick message in seconds.

How Do I Use It?

- Click the **Search bar** at the top of Teams.
- Type a **slash (/)** to see a list of available commands.

Top Teams Slash Commands





Command	Slash Command
Start a call	/call
View recent files	/files
Jump to a team or channel	/goto
Set Do Not Disturb status	/dnd
Get help	/help
Add details to your Teams message	/code, /loop, /gif, /record
Open chat in a new window	/window
Open settings	/settings
Mute the chat	/mute
Unmute the chat	/unmute
Search the page	/find
See your unread activity	/unread
